

Scope of Work

Installation of an ADA Compliant Roll-In Shower

The scope of the work to include but not limited to providing all labor, materials, equipment, services and transportation to complete the work as specified within the scope of work dated July 15, 2019, and necessary to complete the scope in a workman like way. The work to be performed will generally consist of, but; not limited to; the removal and legal disposal of existing interior tub, tub wall finishes down to studs and tub seat complete, coring of existing concrete slab as required for new plumbing, new metal stud walls with blue board and plaster, painting, new fully plumbed ADA accessible shower unit, floor drain, and slip resistant epoxy floor with integrated epoxy baseboard.

All construction work related to the ADA accessible shower unit shall be done per all applicable building codes, and manufacture written installation instruction.

Insurances: \$1 Million in General Liability, and Workmen's Compensation required. 50% Payment Bond required.

Time of Completion: All work shall be completed within 30 days of Notice to Proceed.
