The Brockton Housing Authority, the Awarding Authority, invites sealed bids for **BHA Wide High Rise HVAC (Make-up Air Units) Replacement** in accordance with the documents prepared by TBA Architects, Inc. 9 Damonmill Sq., Ste 5C, Concord, MA 01742.

Project consists of but not limited to: Replacement of rooftop make-up air units at 24-3 Manning Tower, 24-7 Caffrey Towers, 24-8 Sullivan Tower and 24-10 Belair High-Rise. Work will be in occupied spaces. The work being primarily HVAC bids will be accepted with the HVAC Contractor as the prime contractor. Bids will be accepted in the Filed-sub category of Electrical.

The work is estimated to cost approximately \$900,000.00

Bids are subject to M.G.L. c.149 §44A-J & to minimum wage rates as required by M.G.L. c.149 §§26 to 27H inclusive. **Davis Bacon Wages apply.**

General Bids will be received until **2:00 PM, Thursday June 23, 2022**, and publicly opened on-line, forthwith.

General bidders must be certified by the Division of Capital Asset Management (DCAM) in the following category of work: **Prime / HVAC** and must submit a current DCAM Certificate of Eligibility and a signed Update Statement (CQ3).

Each general bidder must submit a completed HUD 5369-A Representations, Certifications and other Statements of Bidders and a completed HUD 2530 Previous Participation Schedule with their bid.

Filed sub-bids for the trades listed below will be received until **2:00 PM, Wednesday, June 16, 2022**, and publicly opened on-line, forthwith.

Filed sub-bidders must be DCAM certified for the trades listed below and bidders must include a current DCAM Sub-Bidder Certificate of Eligibility and a signed DCAM Sub-Bidder's Update Statement.

Filed Sub-bids and General Bids must be accompanied by a bid deposit which shall not be less than five (5%) of the greatest possible bid amount and made payable to the Brockton Housing Authority.

Bid Forms and Contract Documents will be available for pickup on the beginning of the business day on Wednesday, June 1 2022, at <http://www.BidDocsOnline.com> (may be viewed electronically and hardcopy requested). Contract Documents will be available for viewing at Nashoba Blue, Hudson, MA office and/or the Brockton Housing Authority.

There is a refundable plan deposit of **\$50.00** per set (maximum of 2 sets) payable to BidDocsOnline Inc. Deposits must be electronically paid or must be a certified or cashier's check. This deposit will be refunded for up to two sets for General Bidders and for one set for Sub-bidders upon return of the sets in good condition within thirty days of receipt of general bids. Otherwise the deposit shall be the property of the awarding authority. Bidders requesting Contract documents be mailed to them shall include a separate check for **\$40.00** per set for UPS Ground (or **\$65.00** per set for UPS overnight), payable to BidDocsOnline, to cover mailing costs.

A **pre-bid conference** is scheduled for **9:30 AM on Wednesday, June 8, 2022**, at Caffrey Tower, 755 Crescent St., Brockton, MA continuing on to other sites. It is strongly recommended that prospective bidders attend.

The Brockton Housing Authority reserves the right to waive any informalities in or reject any and all bids or to waive any informalities in the bidding. The bids being solicited in this bid package are part of an Energy Performance Contract (EPC) which requires final approval by the Department of Housing and Urban Development's Washington DC office. Therefore, all Contractors must be aware that the bid price(s) submitted herein must be maintained for a period of up to two (2) months. Upon HUD's approval at any time during this period and approval of the BHA's Board of Commissioners, contracts will be issued in a timely manner.
